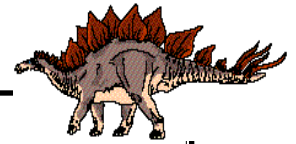
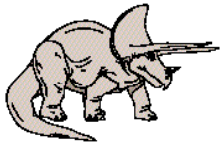

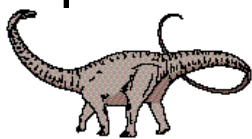

## **World of Dinosaurs Game - Clues**

Ankylosaurs	Family of dinosaurs with bony armor or plates, such as Ankylosaurus
Bipedal	A dinosaur that walked on two legs
Carnivores	Meat eating dinosaurs
Ceratopsians	Family of dinosaurs with horned or frilled heads, such as the Triceratops
Coprolite	Fossilized dinosaur dung
Cretaceous	Third period of the Mesozoic Era
Dinosaur	Term coined by Sir Richard Owen in 1842 meaning fearfully great lizard
Fossils	Plant or animal remains that have been preserved in the Earth
Gastroliths	Stomach stones used by herbivores to aid digestion
Geologist	Scientists who studies rocks and minerals
Herbivores	Plant eating dinosaurs
Jurassic	Second period of the Mesozoic Era
Mesozoic	Era during which the dinosaurs ruled the land
Ornithischian	Refers to bird-hipped dinosaurs
Pachycephalosaurs	Family of "bone heads" that included Pachycephalosaurus and Stegoceres
Paleontologist	A scientist who studies dinosaurs
Pangaea	Huge continent that was found during the Triassic Period
Quadrupedal	A dinosaur that walked on four legs
Saurischian	Refers to lizard-hipped dinosaurs
Sauropods	Family large dinosaurs with long necks and tails, such as Apatosaurus and Diplodocus
Stegosaurus	Family of dinosaurs with bony plates or spikes, such as Stegosaurus
Theropods	Family of large, meat eating dinosaurs that included T-Rex and Allosaurus
Trace Fossils	Fossil evidence of life, such as footprints, burrows, and coprolite
Triassic	First period of the Mesozoic Era
