The cards on the followings pages have been set up so that you punch a hole in the upper-left corner of each one and hold together with a binder ring.

Directions:

- 1. Print the cards on the following pages on card stock.
- 2. Cut the cards apart, but be sure to leave the butterfly's name with its picture.
- 3. Use a hole punch to punch a hole in the upper-left hand corner of each card.
- 4. Laminate if possible.
- 5. Organize using the divider pages (family names) and use a binder ring to hold the cards together.
