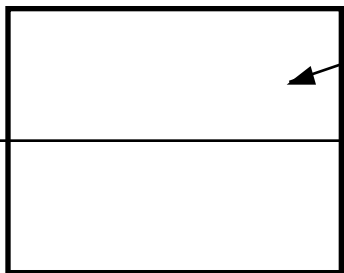

- 4 Where does your butterfly live? List the habitats where you are likely to find it.
- 5 List the food sources for your butterfly as well as its caterpillar.
- 6 Share the winter plans for your butterfly, such as migrate or hibernate.
- 7 Browse the Internet or library resources to discover at least 3 tidbits about your butterfly.
