### **What is the Science Club?**

Each month you will have the chance to compete against other members in science related events. ### **How do I become a member?**

Many of the events are team events allowing you to work with other club members. Encourage your friends to join the Science Club!

### **How do I participate in the events?**

To participate in any event, you need to see me for event rules and sign-up by each event's deadline. You will not be allowed to participate in an event if you fail to sign-up by the deadline.

Most competitions will be scheduled for Saturdays or after school. I will try to avoid conflicts with other school and community events. If an absence is unavoidable, you should see me prior to the event to make alternate arrangements.

### **Do I have to participate in every event?**

No, you can choose the events and activities you want. You will earn points for participating in each event, the annual fund raiser, and other activities throughout the year. Members earning 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place in each event will receive recognition at the annual Awards Day in May. Members who have completed at least half of the year's events and activities will be invited to a special field trip to St. Louis in May.
