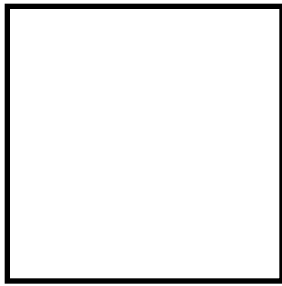
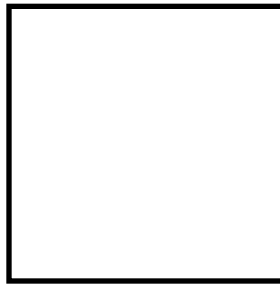


Sand Hunt



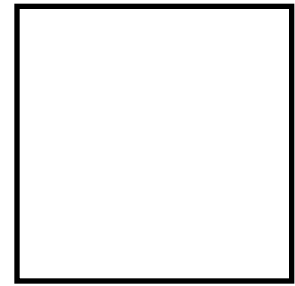
Slate

Crystals are tiny and flat; not shiny, colors range from black to gray



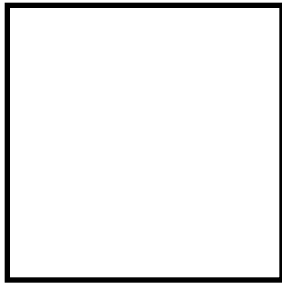
Quartz

Shiny pieces; variety of colors; resembles glass



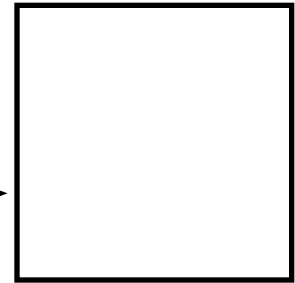
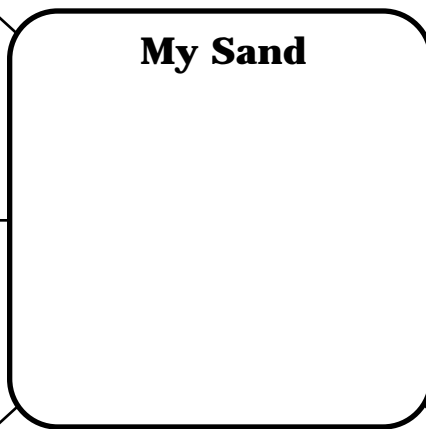
Granite

Large crystals of more than one color; made up of several types of minerals



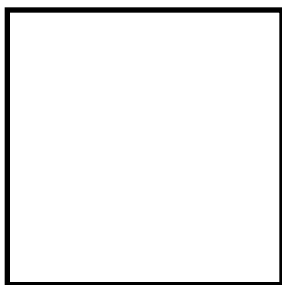
Mica

Small, thin sheets or flakes; shiny luster; ranges in color from clear to dark



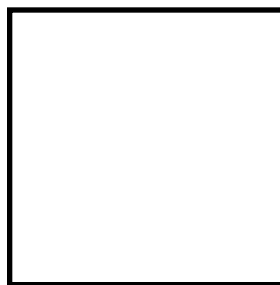
Feldspar

Small pieces that may be flat or jagged; not shiny; color ranges from milky white to beige



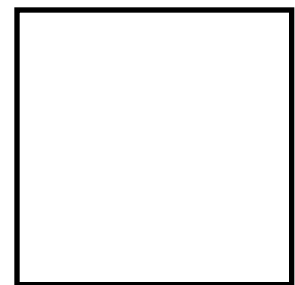
Magnetite

Rounded pebbles; color can be black or brown; attracted to magnets



Limestone

Small pieces that are dull in luster; colors range from white to light brown
